


# Terminology on a Sleeve Pattern

Commercial and indie sewing patterns can call for different notch shapes. The patterns will often have triangular notches because they are easier to see. Since it takes longer to cut triangle notches, I always cut slit notches. Slit notches are also used in production sewing lines to match the pattern pieces together.
